

## HOW WE USED OUR PUPIL PREMIUM ALLOCATION IN 2011/2012

Sharmans Cross Junior School received a Pupil Premium allocation of £10,736. This was based on the number of pupils at our school who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM).

We used the additional funding to contribute to the cost of employing a Child and Family Support Worker to work across the school to support children under pressure and their families.

The impact that this had on the achievement of those pupils in the school in respect of whom was grant was allocated:

*(This equates to 6% of the school roll)*

In 2012/13 we have received a Pupil Premium allocation of £13,200. Our plans for its use include:

- Further work with our Child and Family Support worker to support those children under pressure.
- A contribution to the cost of additional staffing to support small group work and 1:1 work.
