This term, Year Four's writing target is to write in a style appropriate to the tasks set:



I **must** use features of text type in my writing.

I **should** try to write in a 'style' appropriate to the task.

I **could** write clearly for a purpose maintaining the 'style' throughout.

I **could even** adapt a text to a purpose and maintain the reader's interest.

This term, our reading target is to look at similarities and how writers describe settings, especially those that are historical:

I **must** make simple connections between different texts.

I **should** recognise some features that tell us where and when the text is set.

I **could** identify similarities between different texts.

I **could even** comment on the meaning of the text in relation to where and when it is set.



Our maths target is demonstrating problem solving when using & applying a variety of maths.



I **must** use mental recall of addition and subtraction facts.

I **should** add and subtract 2-digit numbers mentally

I **could** use a range of mental methods of computation with all operations,

I **could even** estimate using approximations.

Our science target for this term is to be able to choose appropriate equipment to carry out an investigation.

I **must** present my ideas, observations and measurements in an appropriate way.

I **should** present simple scientific data in more than one way, including tables and bar charts.

I **could** select appropriate ways of presenting scientific data.

I **could even** use the most appropriate formats to present data, such as line graphs points of view.
