

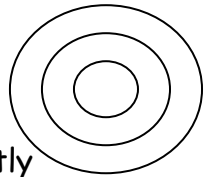

I know that I have achieved my target when I can:

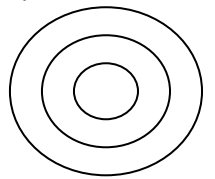
- ✓ use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks mostly accurately to punctuate my sentences.

I know that I have achieved my target when I can:

- ✓ use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks correctly.
- ✓ always use speech marks for direct speech with other speech punctuation.
- ✓ use commas for lists and to show a pause when reading.



I **could** use a full range of punctuation accurately.

I know that I have achieved my target when I can:

- ✓ use a range of higher level punctuation correctly such as colons, semi-colons and dashes.
- ✓ always use commas to mark clauses within the sentences (to show a pause when reading) e.g. in imbedded clauses.
