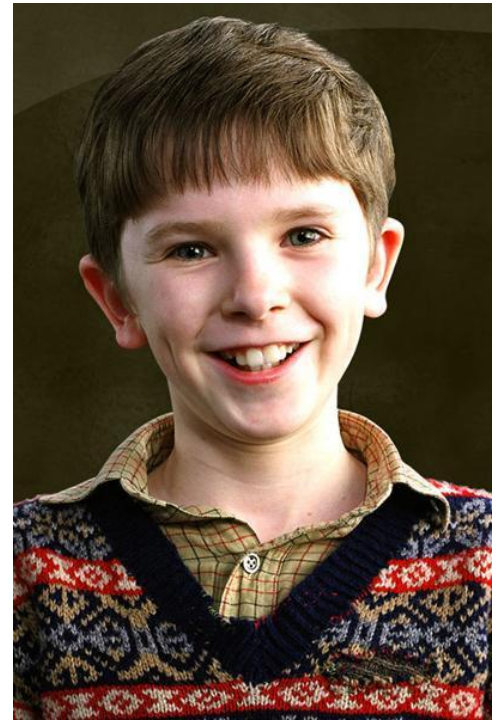


CHOCOLATE CHARLIE
