

# Buckets Of Chocolate

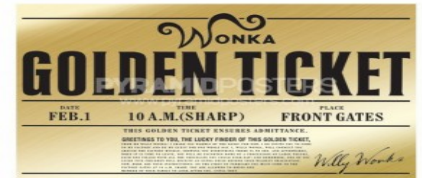
