Another week has flown by! Year 5 pupils have enjoyed a super visit to the National Space Centre in Leicester and came back full of interesting information about the wonderful planetarium! Adam Hobbs, Poppy Hazzard and Lujain Benatia had the following to say:

'Some of the fascinating things we saw was an amazing 42m high rocket, a piece of rock form the moon and a microphone through which the Earth Station communicated with astronauts in space.

One of the best parts of our exciting day was a large dome called 'The Planetarium'. We were shown a video called 'Astronaut' which showed us how astronauts were medically affected and how they trained deep under water in space suits to get used to the limited amount of gravitational support. Also they trained in zero gravity. In order to simulate these conditions, they set a plane to drop rapidly. This helped them when they had to re-enter the Earth's atmosphere. The show was very intriguing, as it made us feel as if we were spinning around at 10mph!

Despite the fact that the centre was a long way away, it was worth it as we learnt loads that will help us in the near future and it was definitely a valuable experience. We had a great time!'

I am delighted to inform you that we now have a defibrillator in school. On Monday, the administration staff and support staff were trained to use it. Many, many thanks to Mrs Hawkes, Halle, Liliana and Cara.
