14 - Open Day (9-11; 1-3; 4- Over the last couple of weeks the school has been immersed in a focused period of self-evaluation as we complete our annual appraisal cycle. We have done classroom observations and held meetings with all of the staff as we begin to consider our targets for next year.

> The process has demonstrated the good quality of teaching and learning that goes on across the school. During our time in classrooms and our discussions with staff we have been able to confirm the clearly targeted and focused work that goes on in classes across the school, engaging and stimulating the children in their learning. We know from the positive relationships that we have seen being developed and used that the classrooms are safe, allowing for children to take calculated risks in a supportive and nurturing environment. We have seen children both meeting and then moving on beyond their learning objectives, meaning that they make good progress.

> As part of this process we have seen children imaginatively and effectively using the iPads to explore their own performance and then look to enhance that even more with the help of their peers acting as coaches. We have seen more and more children being able to identify what went well, what still needs to be improved and considering how best they could make those improvements, all through good quality questioning and prompting by both teachers and peers. All very exciting stuff!

> I would like to thank the staff for allowing us into their classrooms and sharing their excellent practice with us and for their hard work and commitment in providing the children with such interesting, stimulating, positive and safe learning environments that certainly make them safe and feel safe in school.

> Speaking of keeping children safe, can I please ask parents to notify the school if your child is not going to be attending one of our after school clubs. You can do this through the home-school diary or a telephone call. Should a child tell their teacher without this direct contact, we will be phoning parents to confirm the arrangements. This is to ensure that children are where everyone expects them to be and therefore safe and well.
