On Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> February, the school will be thinking about safe internet usage in response to <u>Safer Internet Day</u>. On this day, we will be considering the techniques, strategies and rules for staying safe on the internet.

In Year 6, our focus will be on internet grooming. This is a growing concern, given the increasing access that children have to the internet at earlier ages. As with any other safeguarding issue however, knowledge about the matter and strategies for keeping yourself safe diminishes the risk greatly and allows us to be in control of it.
