Black Country Living Museum Visit

Dear Parents,

As an introduction to our History topic this term on The Victorians, we have planned for Year 6 to visit **The Black Country Living Museum** on **Friday 23rd September** 2011.

This day will provide the children with the opportunity to experience a lesson in a Victorian school, take a tour of an underground mine, explore a range of Victorian homes and shops, ride on an electric tramway and interaction with costumed demonstrators and craftsmen.

The children will need to be in school at 8:30am in order to be registered before the coach departs. We will be returning back to school at approximately 3:30pm (traffic permitting). You will only be notified if there is a significant delay.

Please ensure that your child comes to school with the following:

- Waterproof and warm coat
- A packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, cans or glass bottles please)
- Wearing school uniform with comfortable outdoor shoes (e.g. trainers, walking shoes)
- A snack

If you pay termly for a school dinner, please indicate on the slip below if you require a lunch to be provided by school.

There is no need for your child to bring any money with them on the trip as there will not be time to visit the gift shop due to a packed schedule.

We would be grateful for some parental help to supervise the children. If you are available, please indicate on the slip below.

This year the school is no longer asking for a £50 voluntary contribution. Instead, trips will be paid for as they are planned and occur throughout the year. The cost of this trip will be £12.30 per child, which includes entrance to the museum, coach travel and insurance. Please note that this is a voluntary contribution, however the trip may have to be cancelled if insufficient funds are received. This payment can be made preferably by cheque or by e-payment. If paying by cash, please send in the correct amount in a sealed envelope. Please mark all replies 'For the Attention of Mrs. Fear' and return by **Wednesday 14th September**.
